## Fergus Falls School of Dance Covid Protocols 2022

Due to the current Covid case numbers in Ottertail County FFSD will not be requiring masking when classes start this fall. However our teachers reserve the right to request masks be worn by their students if they feel the need in respect to their own health and safety, and students should be prepared by having a mask in their dance bag. KN95 masks are available for \$2 at all studios. If a student does not have a mask if one is requested to be worn, the \$2 cost will be added to your bill. Teachers and students are always welcome to wear masks, and are encouraged to use KN95 style masks as they are proven to do the best job against airborne bugs.

Air filtration units with HEPA filters and Ion generators will be running in the studios. Hand sanitizing stations will be available in and outside of the studios.

If your student is not feeling well DO NOT SEND THEM TO CLASS! Students who are not feeling well will be sent home from the studio.

There will be no class credits if your student has to quarantine due to Covid infection or exposure. Students are encouraged to make-up classes when cleared. If we have to cancel classes due to teacher illness, you will receive a credit forward.
